## Updates and Reminders

Calor Gas grant - thank you to all those who voted: a massive 14,448 votes were cast on our behalf. We have completed due diligence this week and await the final results. We have sent further evidence of our case using our OFSTED report and a specially made video, with children sharing their views. We will find out whether we have been successful on the 20th of July.

Whilst waiting for the outcome of the Calor panel's deliberations, we have further super news: we are to receive a grant of £1,300 from the Councillors' Priority Fund. This is in addition to the Spark grant for £1,000 announced last week. This means that we now have £2,300 to buy 100 adult chairs and storage holder, event shelter, tea urn, cups and saucers and tableware. Fabulous news: many thanks to the grant team.
