Message from Mrs. Paterson

It has been very encouraging to see the impact of the rather virulent winter vomiting bug gradually diminishing in school. The whole school team has been working extremely hard to ensure that learning has not been impacted by unavoidable absence of staff and pupils. The whole school attendance figure is 95% and we are reminded by the Department for Education that children should not return to school until 48 hours have passed from the last bout of vomiting or diarrhoea, to prevent them passing the illness on.

I have been asked to remind parents and carers who travel to school by car and park in the access road beside school, to be aware that this road must be sufficiently clear for emergency vehicles to use it. There have been a number of incidents where cars are being parked on the corner of the road where it bends (near to the first gate on the school field.) Please would you avoid parking in this space, as parking here could potentially be problematic for an emergency response vehicle that may need to get to the sports facilities. Your co-operation in this matter would be appreciated.
