There will be a series of events for the children and you to take part in. Below is a list of some ideas, and details on how you can get involved:

Event 1 - Jurassic Coast walk

Friends and parents of the school Kenny Naidu-Johnson and Neil Busby have volunteered to take part in a mega walking event on the 21st July, to raise funds for the School Field Project. Their journey will take them 100km along the Jurassic coastal path and will take up to 30 hours, walking day and night.

They are looking for enthusiastic members to challenge themselves, have fun and raise money for a brilliant cause. You don't need to be young and super fit, just have spirit and plenty of determination. There are options to do 25km, 50km or the whole distance.
